Zak Sandler has played piano on Broadway for Wicked, Mean Girls, Motown, and The Color Purple. He performed Inside My Head at the Kennedy Center's Millennium Stage, and developed it as a writerin-residence at the Kennedy Center's page-to-stage festival.

Zak is featured in the American Psychiatric Association's online publication, Psychiatric News, and on Grammy.com. He spoke at the National Convention for the National Alliance on Mental Illness (NAMI), and won the 2018 Young Leader Award from their New York State chapter.

Zak does not use the phrases "mental illness" or "bipolar disorder" because he feels they imply there's something wrong with him. He prefers the term "mental condition" and simply, "bipolar."
